RDO defines sustainable development as development that meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of the future generation to meet their own needs. Youths are having the role of a change agent. RDO initiated a group of youth (18-35) in villages. Three times a year they are getting training on how to promote and upscale the development programmes in the direction of the village as a whole. We create and support conditions under which they can contribute to the economic, social and cultural advancement of their societies and gain self fulfillment.

The school readiness of Anganwadis will begin with repair, painting, and mural arts in the Anganwadis. Early born learning material will be supplied to children to improve their learning abilities and grasping power. Orientation will be provided to mothers on, mother-child relationship, health, and nutrition.
